Rules

The league takes place on the 3G fields (across from Australian Embassy) on Tuesdays. The first games start at **8pm sharp**. We'll play 4-on-4 with continuous play.

Games last 20 minutes, but the game is officially over when the disc is under possession, hits the ground, or goes out of bounds AFTER the whistle has blown (i.e. buzzer beaters count).

Players:

- Every team must have, at all times, have a minimum of 2 women present total and 1 in the field. If a team cannot meet this requirement they will have to 'borrow' a woman from another team or play with 3 players on the field.
- While you may substitute at any given time, the bench player may not enter the field until after the player coming off has tagged them by touching their hand.

Out of bounds:

- If a disc went over the sideline or a turnover happens near the sideline, the offense may establish a pivot 1meter from the sideline closest to where the turnover happened or the disc went out.
- If a disc goes over the endline or a turnover occurs within the defending endzone (of the team that is to be offense after the turnover), then a pivot may be established at the front of the endzone circle.

League scoring:

We play double round-robin games, after which the two teams with the most wins will play a final, while the two teams with the least wins will play a bronze final for 3rd/4th place.

In case of a tie, the difference is determined by rank criteria in this order:

1. Number of games won, counting only games between the teams that are tied.
2. Fewest games where the team had fewer than 2 women (without 'borrowing' from other teams)
3. Goal difference, counting only games between the teams that are tied.
4. Goal difference, counting games against all common opponents.
5. Goals scored per game, counting only games between the teams that are tied.
6. Goals scored per game, counting games against all common opponents.
